This workshop focuses on the personal and collective influence of our ancestral past. Each of us is a living story influenced by generations past. If we learn to hear what is difficult to hear and see what is difficult to see, then we can grasp, better understand repetitions and coincidences in our family and collective history. In a way, we are less free than we think we are as individuals when we recognize we are reliving stories of past generations. It challenges us to re-define many personal healing issues as collective issues that we carry as burdens of the unhealed past. We gain freedom by understanding what happens and bringing healing to all the complexity we have collectively inherited.

Much of the material in the training comes from the book *History Never Ends: Healing our Personal and Collective Trans-Generational Trauma*. This training contains significant new material and expands on previous teachings.

Early registration suggested.
